# LOCAL LAW #1-2005 PROHIBITING ALL NIGHT PARKING IN THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Deerfield, Oneida County, New York, as follows:

#### SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF ALL NIGHT PARKING.

No automobile or other vehicle shall be parked on the paved portion of any Town or County highway within the limits of the Town of Deerfield or any shoulder thereof, between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.

#### SECTION 2. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

Any person violating the provisions of this Local Law shall be guilty of an offense, and upon conviction thereof, be punishable for a first offense by a fine not to exceed \$25.00, and for a second by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$75.00, or by imprisonment for not less than 2 nor more than 15 days. A third offense within any one calendar year or any offense subsequent to the third offense shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$150.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 30 days, or by such fine and imprisonment.

#### SECTION 3. AUTHORITY.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of sub-division 7 of Section 130 of the Town Law of the State of New York and other pertinent provisions of law.

#### SECTION 4. REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES AND LAWS

All Ordinances and/or Local Laws or parts of Ordinances and/or Local Laws of the Town of Deerfield, inconsistent with the provision of this Local Law are hereby repealed; provided, however that such repeal shall be only to the extend of such inconsistency and in all other respects this Local Law shall be in addition to the other Ordinances and/or Local Laws regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this Local Law.

#### **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
