## THE MVWA WILL HOLD A PUBLIC RATE HEARING ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 20 AT 5:00

The Mohawk Valley Water Authority (MVWA) will hold a public rate hearing at <u>5:00 p.m. on Monday</u>, October <u>20</u>, <u>2025</u>. **The rate hearing will be held in the Common Council Chambers on the first floor of Utica City Hall**. The Board of the MVWA is considering a rate increase of 2.0% to take effect on January 1, 2026.

If approved, the rate change will equate to approximately \$9.58 per year in higher water costs for the average household, or about 80 cents per month. The total proposed budget for the coming fiscal year is approximately \$32.46 million.

Some factors considered in the proposed budget include:

- 1. An increase of 15%, or \$144,000, in the payment to the NYS Retirement System. The total payment is estimated at \$1,089,896 for fiscal year 2026.
- Overall water sales and consumption are projected to remain flat with no increase or decrease.
- 3. A decrease in interest earnings of approximately \$347,000 compared to 2025 actual.
- 4. An increase of \$532,000 in funding for smaller capital repair projects that includes piping and valve repairs and buildings and grounds improvements.

The rate increase has been partially offset by a cash carry-forward from accumulated surplus of \$1.6 million. There will be no increase in debt service in 2026.
